

Updated Safety Protocols
for In Person Gatherings

August 30, 2021

- 1) If you are experiencing any cold or flu-like symptoms (fever, cough, shortness of breath) please use one of our online options.
- 2) If you have tested positive for COVID in the last 14 days or have had close contact with or cared for someone diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days, please use one of our online options.
- 3) There are no current capacity limits.
- 4) *The new state mandate is masks are required in public indoor settings, regardless of vaccination status.*
- 5) A touchless hand sanitizer is available as you enter the building to use.
- 6) When selecting your seat, check in with others in the row about their comfort level with sitting right next to each other or if they prefer some physical distance.
- 7) You may talk with others before or after service in small groups. We encourage you to ask others about their comfort level with physical distance.
- 8) If you are ready to give handshakes or hugs, ask for consent prior and respect your neighbor's response. Feel free to be creative with greeting and welcoming others with touchless gestures such as air hugs, air high fives or enthusiastic waves.
- 9) We will not be sharing items such as the offering plate. Those will be available as you enter.
- 10) Communion will be offered every Sunday with using our pre-packaged communion kits and taken at your seat.
